A BIT MORE INFORMATION

- The Journey starts and ends in Nairobi
- 4x4 safari truck transfer between Nairobi and Ol Pejeta
- Transport in four-wheeled drive vehicles for 8 days
- Refreshments in the morning and a chance to feed the giraffes at the Giraffe Centre in Karen on the outward journey to Ol Pejeta
- 8 nights accommodation at The Stables in Ol Pejeta
- All meals are included: lunch and dinner (Day 1); breakfast, lunch, dinner plus tea and cakes (Days 2-8); breakfast and lunch (Day 9)
- Ian Aitken photographer and guide for 8 days
- Daily early morning and evening game drives, when the animals are most active
- Professional photography advice and tuition from Ian Aitken throughout the tour
- Informal afternoon and evening sessions with Ian on photography, digital workflow, post-processing of images
- An evening talk by Richard Vigne, CEO of Ol Pejeta about its conservation work and history
- Bush walk including how to track animals and the chance to take photographs from a different perspective
- Visit to a local community to discover the traditional way of life in this part of Africa, and see the tangible social benefits of the Ol Pejeta Conservancy
- Visit to Nanyuki town and market
- Visit to the David Sheldrick elephant orphanage in Karen to see its rescued elephants on the return journey to Nairobi airport
