

CODE OF CONDUCT

OI Pejeta Conservancy is first and foremost a wildlife reserve. As a visitor you have been given access to a delicate wildlife area, care and attention is required if damage and disturbance to the environment is to be avoided.

OI Pejeta Conservancy reserves the right of access and may ask anyone perceived to be causing disturbance or damage to the environment to leave the Conservancy.

GENERAL CONDUCT

- Strict speed limit of maximum 40 kph.
- Do not discard litter or cigarette butts.
- Off road driving is strictly prohibited (unless approved by management). Keep to designated roads or tracks.
- Beware of dangerous wildlife and do not get out of the car unless in a designated area. Remember you are food.
- Wildlife always has right of way. Do not chase, follow or harass animals.
- Do not feed wildlife from your car, in the wild or at your camp or lodge.
- Do not sit or stand on vehicle's roofs at any time.
- Collection of firewood is prohibited
- Please do not damage or remove any flora or fauna, including bones and plants.
- No driving on the Conservancy is allowed after 7pm
- No firearms, spears, bows and arrows of any kind are to be carried within the Conservancy
- Please ensure that you obtain an official receipt for any cash transaction.

ANYONE CAUGHT BREAKING THE CODE OF CONDUCT WILL BE FINED KSH 5,000 PER PERSON

Daily entrance fee: Single entrance fee valid for 24 hours

Gate times: Entry and exit through Rongai and Serat Gates only. Open daily from 0700hrs. Gates closes at 1900hrs - Strictly.

Proof of residency required:

- East African citizens: National identity card.
- Kenya residents: Valid Passport showing work permit or Alien certificate.

Children: Persons from 3 years and under 12 years.

Student groups: Student groups are required to pre-book to receive the concession Student Entrance Fee. Any group arriving without a booking reference number will be asked to pay the daily entrance rate with no negotiation.

** Applies to bona-fide student groups of no less than 10 pax per group, accompanied by a teacher and/or letter from a recognised learning institution. * 2 teachers per bus will be allowed in FOC.*

Maps: OI Pejeta Conservancy road maps are available to purchase at the gate.

Conservation activities: Rate inclusive of vehicle, guide and drinking water. Activities to be booked at least one day prior, are subject to favourable weather conditions and availability at the time of booking. Children pay 50% of adult rate. Subject to change based on the health and welfare of the animals.

*Rates are inclusive of VAT. Please ensure that you obtain an ETR receipt for all cash payments made.
