



WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE STABLES

THE STABLES

- LOCATION** Functional budget accommodation located near to the main OI Pejeta Office. In addition to hosting long term researchers, The Stables is also available to self-drive individuals or small groups. Children below 3 years are free; children 3-12 years are half price of adult rate.
- ROOMS** Single rooms, double rooms and twin room available as well as single and twin canvas tents. Single rooms, double rooms and twin room have a desk, chair and one power socket. No extension leads or lockable cupboards. There is one hanging rail with clothes hangers, one laundry bucket for placing dirty clothes and wash powder to wash your personal items. Single and twin canvas tents are basic with bed and bedding. Laundry is charged Ksh500 per bucket payable on departure and done only on Saturdays and Wednesdays. **Please note that showers and WCs are separate for men and ladies and shared with the other residents for single rooms and canvas tents, while double rooms and twins are en-suite.**
- CHECK IN** Between 1:00pm and 6:00pm on the date of arrival.
- CHECK OUT** Strictly at 10:00am on date of departure.
- MEALS** 3 meals a day, served in accordance with a set menu. Breakfast: 7am-8am * Lunch: 1pm-2pm * Dinner: 6pm-7pm. Drinking water provided is treated and from an underground source but there is bottled water available for purchase from the Stables duka.
- ELECTRICITY** Power is supplied by a generator which operates at the following times: Monday to Friday 7am - 1pm and 2pm - 12:30am. Saturday and Sunday 7am - 3pm and 6pm - 12:30am.
- INTERNET** Wifi connection is available but only when the generator is on. It is politely requested that no downloading of unnecessary data (e.g. music and videos) is done during working hours as this will slow the system for others.
- PAYMENT** Please book and pay for accommodation via our online booking site <https://olpejetaconservancy.checkfront.com/reserve/>. Current price is US\$ 45 / Ksh 4,600 full board. Unless you are a visiting researcher with prior written approval from management, conservancy entrance fees and vehicle fees are also payable.

DURING YOUR STAY

- Any member of staff will be happy to assist with helping you carry any luggage to your room from the designated car park.
- On arrival you will be requested to sign a Disclaimer form and please return it to the member of staff who has welcomed you to put in your file during your stay. You will also be asked to complete a Guest Registration form at the Reception Desk which includes an agreement to settle all outstanding bills (e.g. laundry) prior to departure.
- Dirty laundry should be placed in the Laundry Bucket supplied in every room. If any item is missing please make it known to the housekeepers on duty as soon as possible. All laundry is hand washed, dried on a line and folded but not ironed. We politely request that all undergarments are washed by yourselves.
- **Breakfast:** Variety of Cereals, Toast & Jams and cooked, **Lunch:** Kenyan Menu of Beans, Stews, Vegetables and Ugali or Chapati; **Dinner:** Hot cooked meal and Puddings. Packed Lunches can be prepared with 1 day notice. **Tea, coffee and drinking water** are available throughout the day. Duka available selling small range of soft & alcoholic drinks, toiletries and snacks.
- Residents are requested not to enter the kitchen at any time and may not use any cooking equipment for their own use.

- Please note that night game drives are only permitted in the company of accredited OI Pejeta staff. Private vehicles are not permitted on night game drives whilst unaccompanied.
